

How does it work?

Each tool in the kit helps you check a different way that energy is used in your home. You can choose to use them all, or focus on one or two, then fill in the workbook provided, or work through your own checklist.



Fridge Freezer Thermometer

Check if your fridge/freezer is set at the right temperature and not wasting energy.



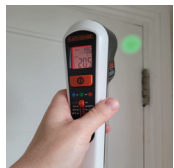
Temperature and Humidity Meter

Measure the temperature and humidity level of each room in your home.



Radiator Key

Release any air trapped in your radiators to make them run more efficiently.



Thermal Leak Detector

See where heat is escaping in your home and where cold air draughts are coming in.



Plug in Energy Monitor

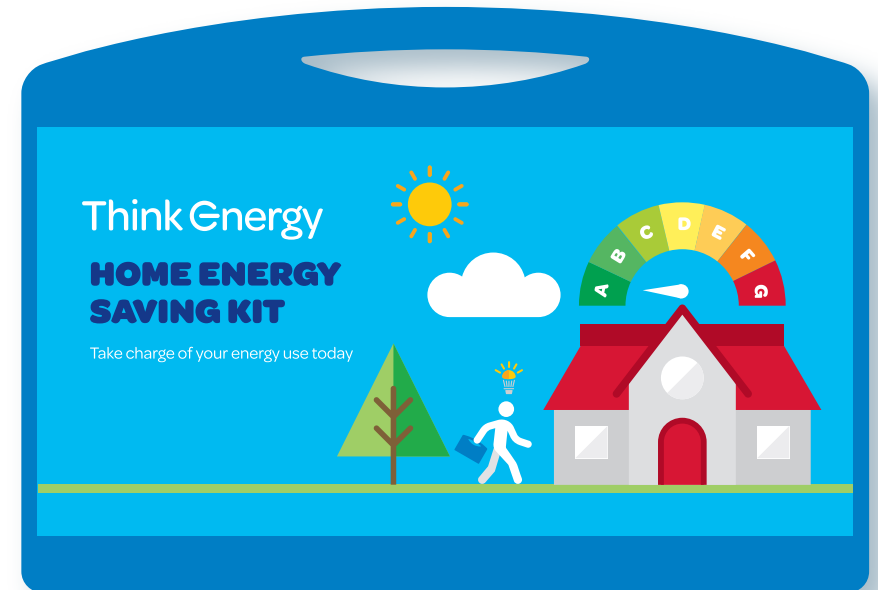
See how much energy is used by each of the appliances in your home.
