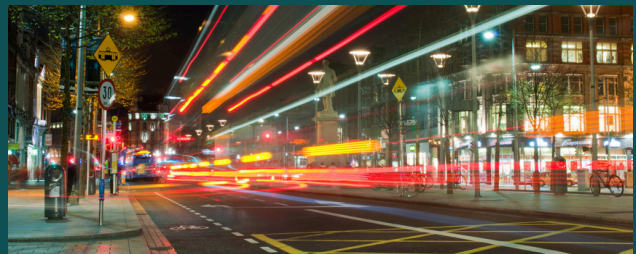
Event Overview

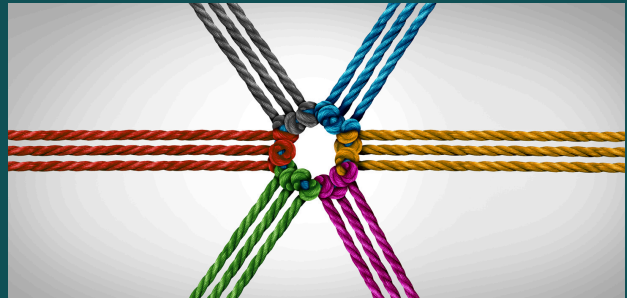

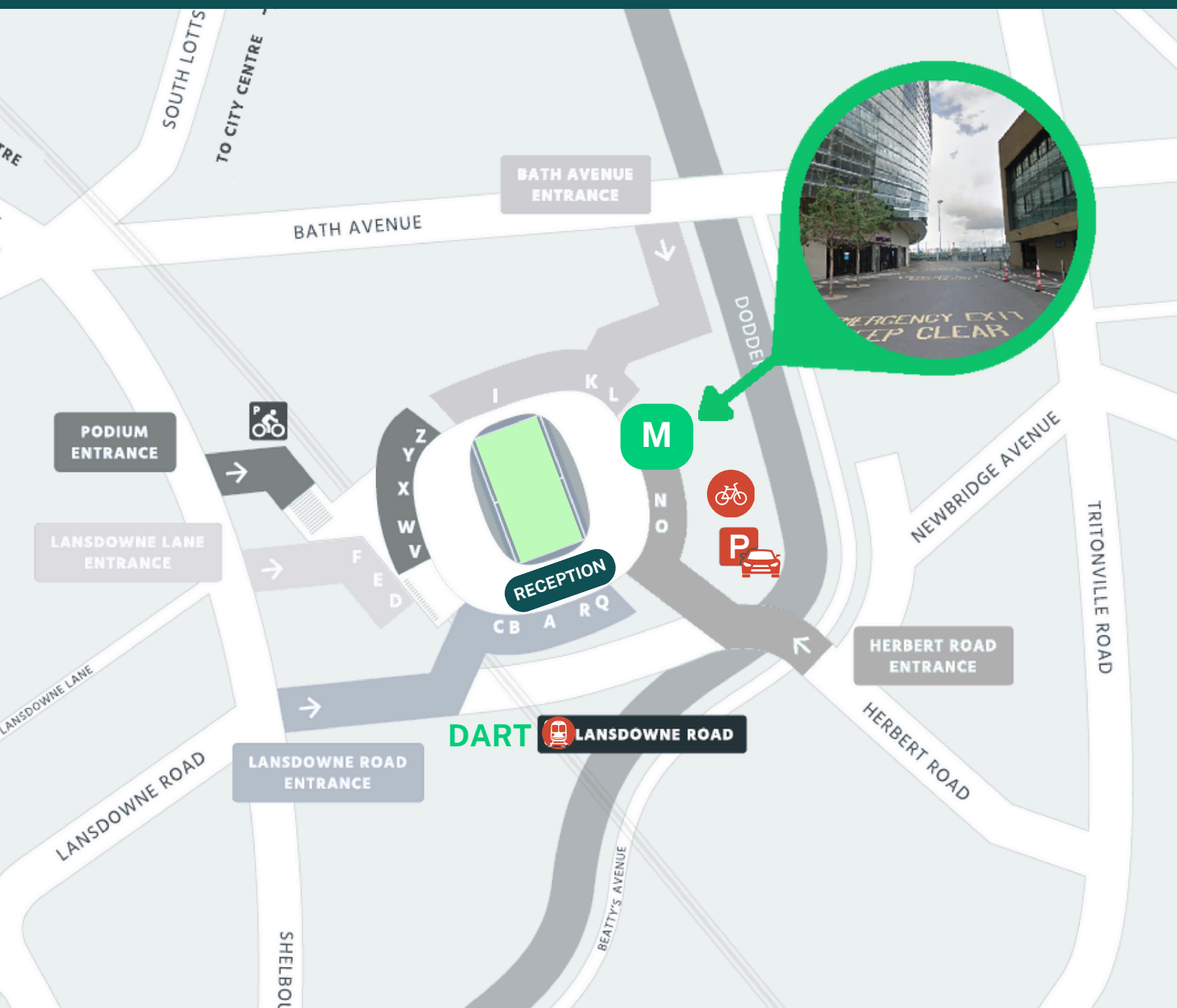

Getting to the Aviva

Given the nature of the event, all attendees are encouraged to travel to the Aviva via active travel or public transport.

The nearest DART station is Lansdowne Road, and the area is also served by Dublin Bus and is a walkable distance from city centre and The Point Luas stop.

There is bike parking on the street outside the venue, as well as in the car park.

Parking is available in the underground public car park beneath Lansdowne Rugby Club (opposite Entrance O). After parking, use the pedestrian exit next to Lansdowne Rugby Club and head toward Entrance M.
